Performance Area: Team events in Masters Gym. Solos and duets in Dodson Auditorium

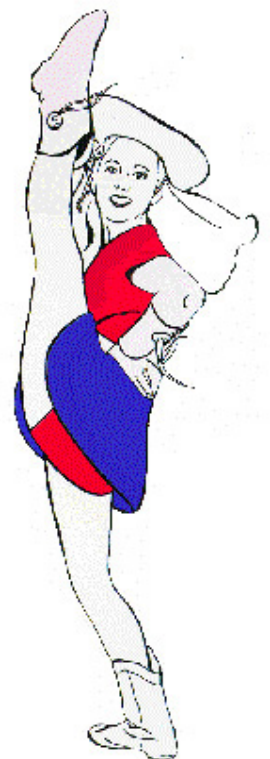
Judges Area: Second level in Masters Gym; center of Dodson Auditorium.

Team Entrance/Exit: Masters Gym – Judges are on the side closest to the Duvall Center. Enter from judges far right (door closest to Duvall Center) and exit to either the right again or the back center door (any door closest to Devall Center side). Dodson Auditorium (solos/duets) – enter and exit from stage right (judges left).

Large Props or Backdrops: If you have large props or backdrops, please keep in mind that there is no storage at all for them inside Master's Gym. ALL PROPS AND BACKDDROPS MUST BE PADDED. For assembly, large staging and props can be brought in one or two categories ahead of the performance for minor assembly and must be removed within a few numbers after the performance. If you have any questions, please contact the office at 800/462-5719.

Sound Area: Masters Gym – located to the side of the gym next to the team entrance. Dodson Auditorium – back stage right.

Floor Surface: Masters Gym is a yellow wood floor with basketball markings. All staging and props must be padded sufficiently and inspected before being allowed on the floor. Dodson Auditorium stage is a wooden stage that is approximately 60 ft x 40 ft.



Dressing Area: The athletic dressing rooms, classrooms and ballroom in the Devall Center will be shared by all teams and assigned at registration.

Results: The director or assistant director may pick up all team, officer, ensemble, duet and solo packets at the awards table immediately following the awards ceremony. Please check your results sacks to make sure that all music and results are inside.

Other Information:

Concessions: Available for purchase at the Student Center, across the street from Masters Gym. No food may be brought into the dressing areas.

Warm-Up Area: The carpeted gym will be available for large teams to warm up. Small teams will warm up in the dance studio or racquetball courts.

Spectator Admission: **\$15 per adult • \$5 per student K-12; 4 and under/65 and older free**

All other spectators, parents and chaperones must either present a VIP pass or pay admission

Spectator Parking: Any lot on campus that does not have a special reserved sign.

Bus Parking: Off site.

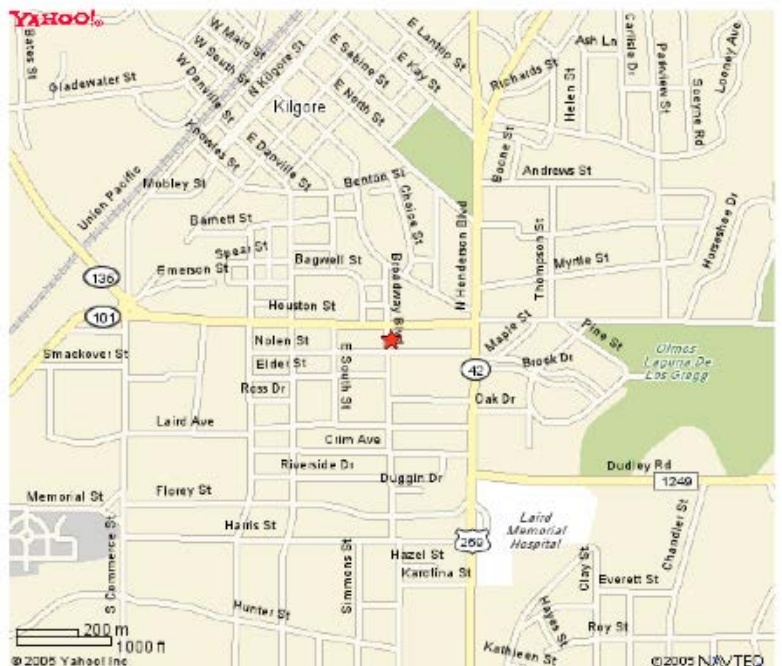

backdrop storage area is available at Masters Gym. All of the proceeds from the Gussie Nell Davis Dance Classic go to benefit Kilgore Rangerette scholarships. Over \$150,000.00 in scholarship money has been generated from this event in the past few years. Current Rangerettes will be on hand as personal team escorts and will perform just before the awards ceremony. 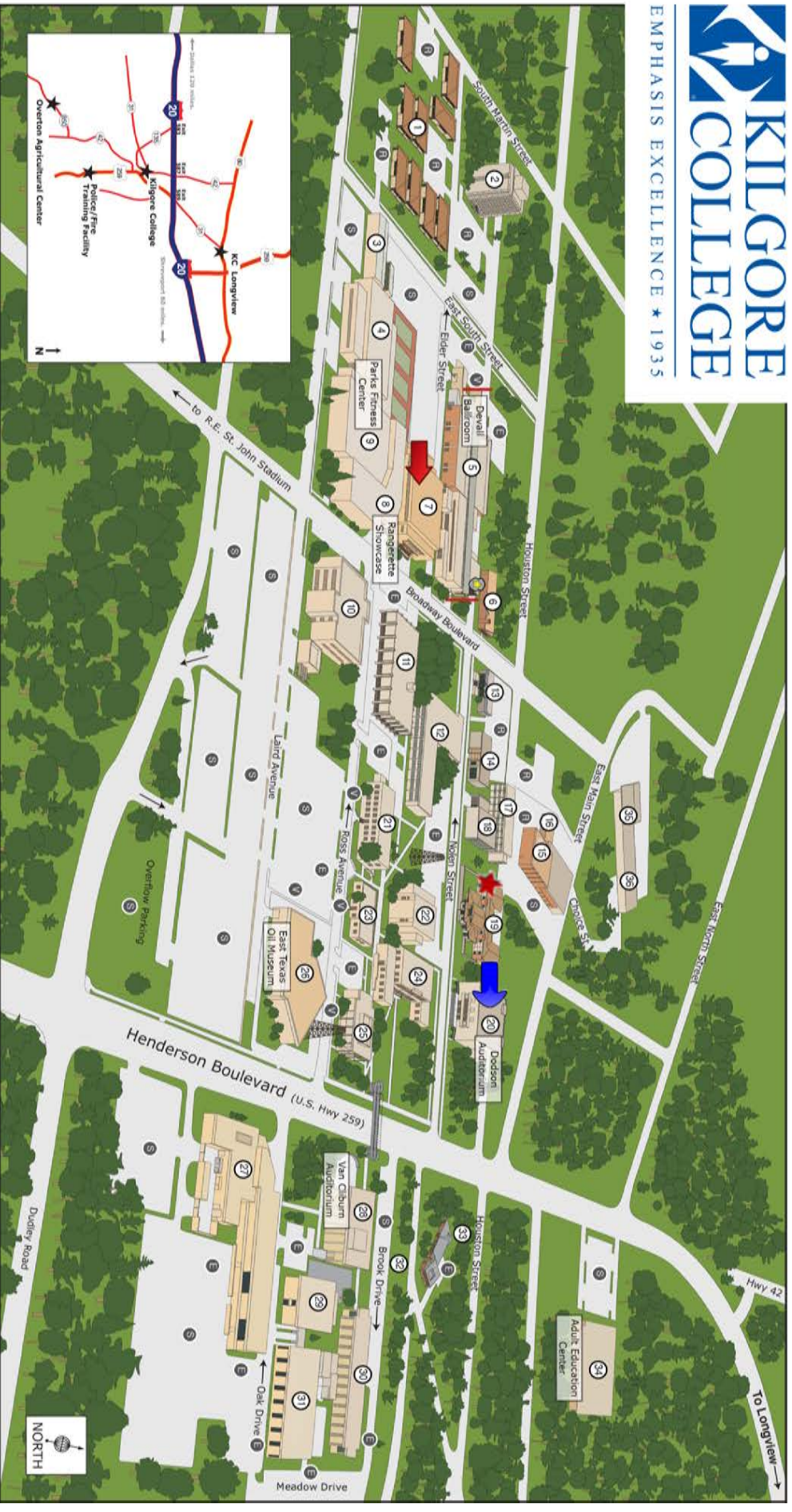
Host Hotel:
