Events Start/End: Friday – approx. 4:00pm – 10:30pm

Saturday – approx. 8:00am – 9:00pm

Please make sure to check the web site for a current schedule the Tuesday prior to the event.

Performance Area: Friday, all high school solos and duets will take place in the Main Gym. All junior high solos and all duets will take place in the Auxiliary Gym on Friday night. All private team solos will perform after the junior high solos on Friday night. On Saturday, all junior high events will take place in the Auxiliary Gym and all high school events in the main gym. The private team events will take place following the junior high events in the auxiliary gym.

Judges Area: About 15 rows up in the center of each team gym. On Friday evening, a third area for middle school and jr solos will be in the auxiliary gym and judges will be floor level.

Team Entrance/Exit: Main Gym - please enter from the hallway at the judges back left and exit to the judges right to the foyer.

Auxiliary Gym- please enter from the hallway and exit from the judges back left.

Sound Area: Both Gyms - on side of gym next to team entrance, floor level.

Floor Surface: Both gyms are yellow hard wood with basketball markings.

Dressing Area: The classrooms will be assigned by the Olathe East Talons.

Results: The director or assistant director may pick up all team, officer, ensemble, duet and solo packets at the awards table immediately following the awards ceremony. Any team needing to leave early because of inclement weather must check with the contest administrator

to make arrangements to pick up results packets and awards. The awards and results cannot be shipped.

College Teams: The Kansas Spectacular welcomes many college dance team programs in the area to be our guest performers and set up a recruiting table in the foyer. It is necessary for any interested team to go online and register, at a small fee, so that we may include you in the program and prepare a spot for you in the foyer. You will receive a list of the high school teams that participate along with their email addresses for recruiting purposes, as well as a video/audio critique on a USB flash drive, that will help your team prepare for nationals.
