



Summer Camp Confirmation

Please make sure to arrange for your payment to be sent in a timely manner to our office. We must have your payment in our office 3 weeks prior to your camp date. If your deposit is received after that three week deadline, there will be a **\$25 per person late fee** charged to us by the university or hotel. **Please add this to your balance.** Please make sure to request your check early.

EARLY ARRIVALS

☞ Please notify our office **IMMEDIATELY** if you plan to arrive a day early for college campus camps. Cost is \$25 per person (Centenary and Emporia only). Early arrival times are **4:00 to 7:00 pm ONLY**. No exceptions. Hotels will require an extra reservation to arrive the night before.

☞ If you plan to arrive a day early for SMU (Dallas) or any of the camps housed in hotels, you **MUST** make arrangements by booking the hotel directly on your own. Emporia and Centenary will allow early arrivals if reserved through our office in advance. Space is limited. Please book early.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

The **balance is due prior to your summer camp**, to be paid for in **one check** from your school account, or we are required to add state and local tax. Please include your tax exempt form or number with your check. If your school requires an invoice to issue a check, please contact our office at least three weeks prior to your camp and one can be e-mailed or faxed to you. (Contact **BarbADTS@aol.com** for Barbara, our accounts manager)

CHECK IN AT THE DORM/HOTEL FIRST--THEN REGISTER AT SITE OF OPENING MEETING.

1. **MEDICAL FORMS:** For some camps, you may duplicate the medical form enclosed for each of your team members and keep them with you at all times. SMU and Emporia students must use the forms that have been e-mailed to you in advance. SMU will need each student to bring the original plus 3 more copies of their form to camp registration. Emporia will only need one copy. For all other camps, please use the form in this file and bring one copy, or use a copy of each girl's school medical form that you use, with you to camp.

2. **REGISTRATION:** Please make note of the times, locations, etc. mentioned on the enclosed form for registration. At most camps, classes will begin at 9:30 am with the opening meeting and Camp Dance/Dance Technique Class on the first day. Please check your camp schedule on our web site for exact times and information. Please bring all medical forms (all camps) and liability forms (SMU only) with you to registration.

3. **CANCELLATIONS:** Please notify the office immediately of any cancellations or changes. Cancellations and refund requests must be made **IN WRITING**. For those cancellations received later than **14 days prior to camp**, **no refunds or credits will be issued**. All deposits are non-refundable, and no refunds will be issued prior to September 1st. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED AT CAMP**. **IMPORTANT:** If cancelling within 14 days of Day 1 of camp, you will be charged the full Room & Board fee of \$150 per person. If you have not pre-paid the entire room and board, you will be invoiced for the difference.

4. **BRING:** Students staying in college campus housing will need to bring twin bed sheets, towels, pillows, blanket, soap, and toiletries to all camp locations. Hotel campers do not need any linens. **YOUR SCHOOL WILL BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED BY YOUR STUDENTS TO THE DORM OR HOTELS.**

5. **SCHEDULE:** Remind your team members of the **rigorous schedule**, and come to camp in good condition ready to work and learn. This will help avoid injury. They may want to bring a **small thermos for water**, so they can consume plenty of liquids. Ice chests are not allowed in the dorms at SMU (see information about renting mini-refrigerators from Mustang Rental). Make sure everyone has proper footwear for indoor dance classes. Some routines may contain floor work where they may utilize knee pads for protection. Some hotels require check out by 11:00am. Please be prepared to store luggage or load early prior to Final Evaluation. At hotels, check in is after 3:00 pm and check out is by 11:00 am unless otherwise arranged.

6. **MEALS:** Please note that the **meals** college campus 3-day camps go from lunch of Day #1 to lunch of Day #3. Some campuses will offer lunch on a cash basis, while others will have several fast food restaurants bordering the campus. **Hotel camps will include 3 lunches and 2 dinners.** Breakfasts will be on your own to keep camp costs to a minimum. See brochure or web site for specific

details. All other meals will be on your own. You may contact our office to have suggestions or arrangements for additional meals for your team. Please encourage your team members to eat all three meals daily to help fuel their bodies for their intense days of workouts. No meals will be included at commuter camps unless specified.

7. **AWARDS:** Read over the "**Awards and Evaluation**" page on our web site to better prepare you and your team for camp procedures. If you have any questions about camp procedures, please feel free to contact our office.

8. **DVD:** You are welcome to bring **video equipment** to tape the workshops, home routine night, final evaluation, etc. If you have brought all your team members to line camp, private camp or officer camp, you will receive the Visual Notes DVD.

9. **LARGE PROPS:** Please tape or pad all large props in order to protect the floor. No glitter is allowed in hotel ballrooms. You will be responsible for any damages.

10. **DOOR DECORATIONS:** Please be aware that it is not a safe practice to have the team member's names on the outside door decorations. This will give a stranger the student's name that could be a safety issue for them. Most hotels will not allow any door decorations at all. Please check with the hotel or dorm manager before taping any decorations on the doors.

→ Some campuses and hotels will be strict about their **11:00 am check out time** on the final day of camp, so you may need to plan to either store your luggage after breakfast on the last day or have your buses meet to pick up luggage early.

→ Because of our commitments for guarantees to the universities and hotels, we must require that you be **paid in full at least 3 weeks prior to your camp**. All camps will need to have either a **P.O. or deposit at least 30 days in advance**. Please make sure to request your school check early. All teams must be paid in full prior to camp.

STUDENT CAMP CONFIRMATION

1. Check with your director regarding the **location of registration**. Dorm registration is usually from 8:00 am - 9:00 am on the first day of camp. Hotels will not allow check in until after 3:00pm, but will provide a place to store your luggage. Remember that schedules may vary slightly from camp to camp so check times as soon as you arrive at camp and inform parents of all of the important performance and meeting times.
2. Please note that the **meals** at a three day campus camps will begin with lunch on Day #1 and end at lunch on Day #3. Some college campuses will offer lunch on a cash basis, while others will have several fast food restaurants bordering the campus. Hotel camps will provide lunch and dinner only (Renaissance, Omni, Hilton Bella Harbor and Moody Gardens). Breakfasts and other meals will be on your own or arranged by your director. We encourage you to eat all 3 meals daily and drink plenty of water to fuel your body for classes.
3. Your family and friends are invited to observe **Home Routine Night** on the first evening of camp as well as **All American auditions** (last afternoon of camp) and **Final Evaluation** on the last day of camp. Please check with your director or the ADTS® web site for the exact times and location on the camp schedule.
4. Bring plenty of **comfortable clothing** to work out in and proper footwear such as tennis shoes. Bring band-aids or medical tape for blisters from new dance shoes. See Mustang Rental form for SMU refrigerator rental.
5. If you are staying on a college campus, bring your own pillow, twin bed linens, towels, soap and personal items, as they are not provided by the University. Students staying in a hotel need not bring these items. You may want to bring a thermos for water. Do not forget an alarm clock and a cover up to wear to and from classes (pants, shorts, or warm-up). Officers should bring a pad and pen to workshops to take notes. (Each officer group will receive an Officer Handbook with reference material for classes and workshops on a CD (officer/leadership camp only).
6. Cancellations and refund requests must be made **in writing**. **For those cancellations received later than 14 days prior to camp, no refunds or credits will be issued. All deposits are non-refundable, and no refunds will be issued prior to September 1st. No refunds will be issued at camp. IMPORTANT: If canceling within 14 days of Day 1 of camp, you will be charged up to \$175 per person.** (see registration form for costs) If you have only paid a deposit, your school will be invoiced for the balance.
7. Any charges you incur at the University Health Center or local medical service will either be **YOUR'S OR YOUR DIRECTOR'S** responsibility. Please bring an insurance card to camp.
8. Please complete and return your **medical form** to your director before camp (see below, except for **SMU and EMPORIA STATE**--see director for special forms). There is a new Liability form for SMU. Please make sure that you have completed this and returned to your director. The director will turn it in at camp registration.

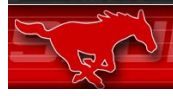

Southern Methodist University

CITY/LOCATION: Dallas, Texas, near Central Expressway (Hwy 75 North) and Mockingbird Lane.

REGISTRATION: Dorm Registration is from **8:00 am - 9:00 am**. **NEW!!!! All directors will need to go pick up keys at Moody Coliseum and receive your dorm assignment there. If you have a bus, please keep students on the bus while you pick up their keys, then have the bus drop them at their dorm.** For SMU Line Camp we are using McIlvaney Dorm. Send in the director with the room list to find out which dorm you will be staying in, then have your bus take you to that particular dorm for dorm check in. We ask that you check into the dorms first, and then come back to Moody to register with ADTS® just before the first class.

American Dance/Drill Team® Registration is from 9:30 am - 10:00 am. **Registration** for SMU Line Camp will be at Moody Coliseum. Please check the final schedule on the web site posted the week prior to camp in case locations change. **All groups must be checked out on the last day of SMU by 4:00pm.**

EARLY ARRIVALS: All early arrivals will be lodged at the Doubletree Hotel, the Radisson Hotel, (or the hotel of your choice) located on Central Expressway, near the campus. You will need to provide your own transportation to and from campus daily. For reservations call the **Doubletree Tree 214/691-8700**

DORMS: Dorm registration will be held from 8:30 am - 9:30 am at the designated dorm. We are working on a new check in procedure that should expedite your check in. Please make sure that you have your rooming list prepared and with you. These dorms have individual rooms for 2 persons with bath facilities on each floor. Each year, Mustang Rental offers small refrigerators for rental in dorm rooms. Check out time for the dorms is 4:00pm. Space is limited and directors may be asked to share a room with another director if private rooms are un-available. Lost room key is \$75.00 (Lost meal card is \$10). If furniture is moved, you may be charged from \$25 to \$300.

FOOD: The dining and food is superb at SMU with the recent renovation of the dining facility in Lee Center. Meal tickets for commuting students are \$50.00 for SMU Line Camp. **Please notify the office if you want to purchase meal tickets at least 2 weeks in advance of camp.** Lost Vali-dine card (meal ticket) charge is \$10.00 (+ neck cord \$2).

TEACHING FACILITIES: All of the dance classes are held indoors in air conditioned facilities on the SMU campus. We utilize Moody Coliseum, Dedman Gym & Dance Studios and marching classes are held in Dedman Gym.

EXTRAS: At SMU camps American Dance/Drill Team® provides each student with medical insurance coverage, which provides for any necessary emergency medical treatment at the student infirmary during the day. You must report to the SMU trainer or security to receive medical treatment covered by insurance. There will also be a trainer on duty in the evening for injury consultation and prevention. Any emergencies after class hours must be handled through the SMU police department or a local emergency medical facility. Parking passes will be required for all vehicles on campus at the cost of \$3.00 each.

SPECIAL INTEREST: SMU represents the "Capitol" for drill teams. American Dance/Drill Team® held the very **FIRST** drill team camp in the U.S. here in 1958 by Gussie Nell Davis and Dr. Irving Dreibrodt.

CITY/LOCATION: Emporia State University is located in the beautiful City of Emporia, Kansas. It is one of the most attractive college campuses in the country.

REGISTRATION: Teams should report to **North Towers** to get your keys, to check in for residents between 8:00 am and 9:30 am. You should receive an e-mail in advance of camp as to your dorm assignments. ADTS registration will be from 9:30-10 am on the second floor of the Student Center. Sleeping rooms are limited this summer due to massive renovations on campus.

HOME ROUTINE/AA AUDITIONS/FINAL EVALUATION for **line camp** will be held in the **Albert Taylor Hall Auditorium**. The stage is **30 ft. deep X 36 ft. wide** and has black back and side draping. Please plan your routines accordingly.

EARLY ARRIVALS: All early arrivals can be housed on campus. Make sure to register this information with our office.

DORMS/FOOD: Drill Teams will be housed in the **North Tower** that will be **two** to a room. You will need to bring bath and bed linens with you (they no longer provide your bed linens). Meals will be served at the on the second floor of the Memorial Union, while the cafeteria is being remodeled. The Twin Towers dorm is just about 200 yards from the Memorial Union to make for a very short walk to class and meals. Lost key charge is \$25; lost dining card is \$10. There will be a \$10 charge for any change in furniture configuration in the rooms.

TEACHING FACILITY: Classes will be taught in the air conditioned ballrooms and conference rooms of the Memorial Union. This year there will be construction in the Memorial Union and Kanza, Flint Hills and Greek will be out of service. We will be using the ballroom, Web Lecture Hall, the ballroom, and the ATH Stage, along with other rooms for classes. There is ample space for over 300 students. We are elated about the beautiful facilities offered to our group at Emporia State.

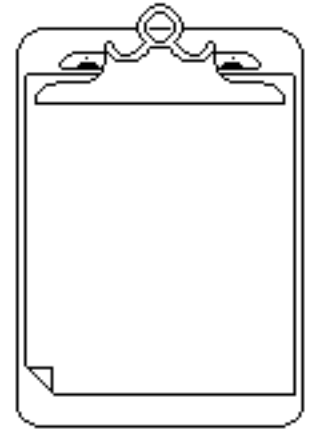

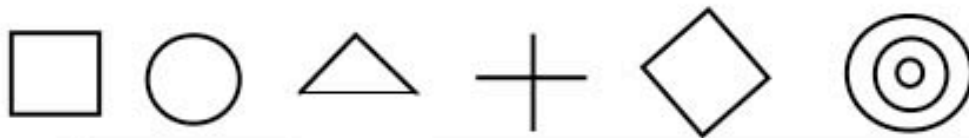
